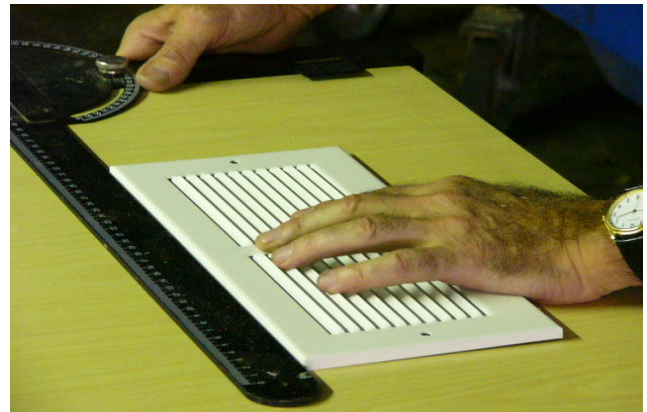
Hampton Court Mews is a new highly desirable residential development built by Barrett Homes West London. The apartments are situated on the southern bank of the River Thames, some of which afford views over Hampton Court Palace. Each pied-à-terre is equipped with a gas boiler concealed within a cupboard which is protected by an Ash foiled FD 30(S) door. To allow the free flow of ambient air Mann McGowan® Installations has undertaken a contract to cut two small apertures in each door and fit them with a Mann McGowan Pyrogrille® fire resisting air transfer grille.



Each door was carefully removed from its hinges, taken down to the basement car park, where the apertures were cut out and the Pyrogrille® dampers were fitted.

The units were also fire stopped around the clearance gaps with Pyromas® acrylic based intumescent mastic.

Steel cover grilles were then fitted to both sides of the dampers, and the doors were then re-hung to ensure that they closed correctly.



Mann McGowan Installations has undertaken this type of work on a number of projects throughout the UK. The company has an upgrading division which specialises in up-grading fire resisting doors. Work undertaken includes the fitting of intumescent fire-cold smoke and acoustic seals, as well installing new ironmongery, glazing and re-glazing. In addition the division can up-grade and repair panelled doors.
