Weydon Secondary School undertook numerous alterations to the existing building. The link corridor on the ground floor runs adjacent to the new mathematics room that has been built. Project architects Mouchel Parkman wanted to provide natural light into the corridor from the classroom, but had to consider fire resistance, safety and privacy when specifying the dividing glazed screens.



Mann McGowan® Pyrovista® 30 paint grade timber screens were the solution chosen. The scheme required that the frames and doors would match the existing doors and frames within the school complex.

The screens were glazed with 6mm thick clear fire resisting/safety glass which had an “etch-like” finish applied to the lower panes of glass which provide classroom privacy from the pupils walking past the screens in the corridor. Certifire approved FD30(S) flush doors were fitted within the screens all fitted with Mann McGowan’s Certifire approved Pyrostrip® and Pyroglaze® intumescent seals.
